

FARRUKHABAD AT A GLANCE



Sankisa is a historically important Buddhist-heritage site, believed to be the place where Buddha descended back to earth from heaven, giving it great religious significance.



Neeb Karori Baba Ashram (in Nib Karori village, Farrukhabad) is important because it marks the place where Neem Karoli Baba spent many years in meditation and service this ashram is considered the origin of his spiritual journey, and his name itself is derived from this village.



Panchal Ghat lies on the bank of Ganga (or RamGanga/Kali-Ganga) and serves as a traditional river-ghat for religious rituals, aartis and fairs locally significant for spirituality and community events.



Kampil was the capital of ancient Panchala kingdom (southern part), and according to tradition, the famed Swayamvara of Draupadi took place here linking it deeply to the epic Mahabharata.



The Pandaveshwar Nath Temple is believed to have been established by the Pandavas during their exile, making it a sacred site linked to Mahabharata.



Fatehgarh Fort is a historic structure built during the British period, known for its old cantonment and strategic location along the Ganga.

DELICACIES OF FARRUKHABAD



It is a dry mixture typically made from fried lentils (moth dal), spices, sev, nuts, and sometimes dried fruits, offering a unique crunchy texture and a complex sweet, salty, and spicy flavor profile.



Farrukhabadi bhune aloo are a famous street food from the Farrukhabad district of Uttar Pradesh, known for its significant potato production. These potatoes are traditionally roasted in hot sand or embers in large street-side furnaces/ovens), giving them a unique smoky flavor and texture.



Farrukhabadi papdi (or papadiya) is a famous traditional street-food chaat from Farrukhabad, made with crispy wheat discs, boiled potatoes, chickpeas, fresh vegetables, curd, and a special local spice blend.
