PREAMBLE

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is executed on **Date:** 11/08/25 with the mutual intent of fostering academic collaboration between the First Party and the Second Party in the areas of **teaching, learning, research, faculty and student development, academic exchange, skill development, and professional education**.

- Provide opportunities for seminars, workshops, conferences, training programmes, and academic activities; and
- Promote holistic academic and professional development of students and faculty members.

PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT

The primary purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is to establish a **mutually beneficial academic partnership** between the First Party and the Second Party with the objective of strengthening academic cooperation, research activities, knowledge exchange, and professional development.

Enhance Academic Excellence

Promote quality education through academic interaction, sharing of teaching methodologies, learning resources, and best academic practices.

2. Promote Faculty & Student Exchange

Facilitate exchange of faculty members, students, scholars, and academic experts for lectures, training, academic visits, and other educational activities.

3. Encourage Research & Innovation

Promote collaborative research projects, interdisciplinary research, innovation, consultancy, publications, and participation in research-oriented activities.

4. Facilitate Knowledge Sharing

Organize guest lectures, seminars, conferences, workshops, webinars, FDPs, training programmes, and other academic events jointly.

5. Strengthen Skill Development

Provide students with opportunities to enhance their technical, practical, communication, leadership, and professional skills.

6. Promote Career & Higher Education Opportunities

Facilitate career guidance, competitive examination guidance, higher education counselling, internships, project work, and professional development activities.

AREAS OF WORK UNDER THE AGREEMENT

To achieve the objectives of this collaboration, the following areas of academic cooperation are identified between the First Party and the Second Party:

1. Faculty Exchange & Academic Interaction

- Exchange of faculty members for guest lectures, expert talks, academic discussions, and teaching-related activities.
- Faculty interaction for sharing innovative teaching and learning methodologies.
- Joint academic meetings and discussions on emerging trends in higher education.
- Faculty participation in academic and professional development programmes organized by either party.

2. Student Exchange & Academic Exposure

- Facilitation of student visits and academic exchange programmes.
- Participation of students in seminars, workshops, conferences, competitions, and other academic activities organized by either party.
- Opportunities for students to interact with faculty members, researchers, and subject experts.
- Promotion of interdisciplinary learning and academic exposure.

Joint Seminars, Workshops & Conferences

- Organization of joint seminars, conferences, workshops, webinars, symposiums, and training programmes.
- Participation of faculty members and students in academic events conducted by either party.
- Sharing of academic resources and expertise for successful organization of such programmes.

4. Research & Development Collaboration

- Undertaking joint research projects in mutually identified areas.
- Collaboration in research publications, review articles, case studies, and academic projects.
- Encouragement of interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary research.
- Promotion of innovation, entrepreneurship, patents, and other research-related activities.
- Exchange of research ideas, methodologies, and academic expertise.

5. Curriculum Enrichment & Academic Development

- Sharing of academic expertise for curriculum enrichment and development.
- Interaction among faculty members regarding emerging subjects, technologies, and educational practices.
- Industry/academic expert lectures wherever appropriate.
- Development of value-added courses, certificate programmes, and skill-based academic programmes.

6. Internship, Training & Project Work

- Facilitation of internship and training opportunities for eligible students, wherever feasible.
- Collaboration in student project work, dissertation work, field studies, and academic assignments.
- Guidance and mentoring of students by faculty members and subject experts.
- Academic supervision and evaluation of projects as mutually agreed.

7. Faculty Development Programme

- Organization of joint Faculty Development Programmes (FDPs), training programmes, orientation programmes, and refresher programmes.
- Sharing of expertise in emerging areas of teaching, research, technology, and academic administration.
- Encouragement of faculty members to participate in professional development activities.

8. Academic Resources & Knowledge Sharing

- Sharing of academic materials, research resources, educational content, and best practices, subject to applicable rules.
- Mutual use of academic facilities, laboratories, libraries, seminar halls, and other resources wherever feasible and mutually agreed.
- Exchange of information regarding academic programmes, conferences, research opportunities, and scholarships.

9. Publications & Intellectual Contribution

- Joint publication of research papers, books, book chapters, conference proceedings, newsletters, and other academic materials.
- Joint academic projects and scholarly activities may be undertaken with mutual consent.

- Authorship and intellectual contribution shall be appropriately acknowledged as per applicable academic and institutional norms.

10. Career Guidance & Professional Development

- Organization of career counselling and professional development programmes.
 - Guidance regarding higher education, competitive examinations, research opportunities, and professional careers.
 - Conducting resume-building, communication skills, interview preparation, and soft-skill development programmes.
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DURATION

This Memorandum of Understanding shall remain effective for a period of **five (5) years** from the date of its execution.

Upon expiry, the MoU may be **renewed, extended, or revised** through a written agreement mutually consented to and signed by both parties.

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Autonomy & Independence

- Both parties shall maintain their respective institutional autonomy and independence.
- Nothing contained in this MoU shall be construed as creating a legal partnership, joint venture, agency, or employment relationship between the parties.
- Each party shall remain responsible for its own institutional policies and administrative decisions.

2. Non-Financial Nature

- This MoU does not create any mandatory financial obligation upon either party.
- Any financial expenditure associated with a specific joint activity shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing before commencement of such activity.
- Participation in any programme shall be subject to availability of resources and institutional approval.

3. Confidentiality

- Both parties agree to maintain confidentiality regarding confidential academic, research, institutional, or other sensitive information shared during the course of collaboration.
- Confidential information shall not be disclosed to any third party without prior written consent, except where required by law.

4. Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)

- Intellectual Property Rights arising from any jointly undertaken research, project, innovation, publication, or other academic activity shall be mutually decided by the parties.
- Ownership, authorship, licensing, and usage rights shall be documented separately wherever required.

Academic Standards & Approvals

- All academic activities under this MoU shall be conducted in accordance with applicable rules, regulations, guidelines, and academic standards of the respective institutions.
- Wherever required, prior approval of the competent authority shall be obtained before conducting any programme.

6. Amendments

- Any amendment, modification, or addition to this MoU shall be made in writing and shall become effective only after approval and signature by the authorized representatives of both parties.

7. Termination

- Either party may terminate this MoU by providing **thirty (30) days' written notice** to the other party.
- Termination shall not affect activities already commenced, unless mutually agreed otherwise.
- Both parties shall endeavour to complete ongoing academic commitments in a mutually acceptable manner.

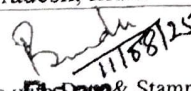
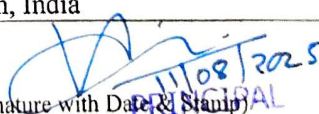
8. Dispute Resolution

- This MoU is non-exclusive in nature.
